Directions to Wright Auditorium: Park for free in the Giraffe parking lot (first parking garage to your left as you drive up Penny Lane). Enter the hospital through the Giraffe entrance, located straight across from the parking garage. Continue straight past the giraffes, the auditorium is on the left.
