Our AHA-authorized PALS courses are rich in pediatric experience and leadership with highly qualified physician, nurse and paramedic PALS Instructors from a variety of specialties including pediatric anesthesia, pediatric critical care, emergency medicine and airlift and ground emergency transport.

### PALS Course Description

PALS is a comprehensive course that emphasizes early recognition of pre-arrest states and the prevention of cardiopulmonary arrest in infants and children. The PALS Provider Course and the PALS Renewal Course follow the curriculum developed by the American Heart Association (AHA) and the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP). Upon successful completion, participants will be granted a PALS certification card through the AHA-designated training center.

### PALS Course Objectives

At the completion of the PALS Provider and Renewal Courses, the participant will be able to:

1. Utilize AHA assessment and management tools to assess, categorize, decide and act on respiratory failure, cardiac rhythm disturbances and shock in infants and children.
2. Demonstrate team approach to resuscitation, serving as team leader and team member.
3. Demonstrate effective techniques in basic life support, airway maintenance, vascular access, cardiac electric therapy and pharmacologic therapy.
