



Driving directions:

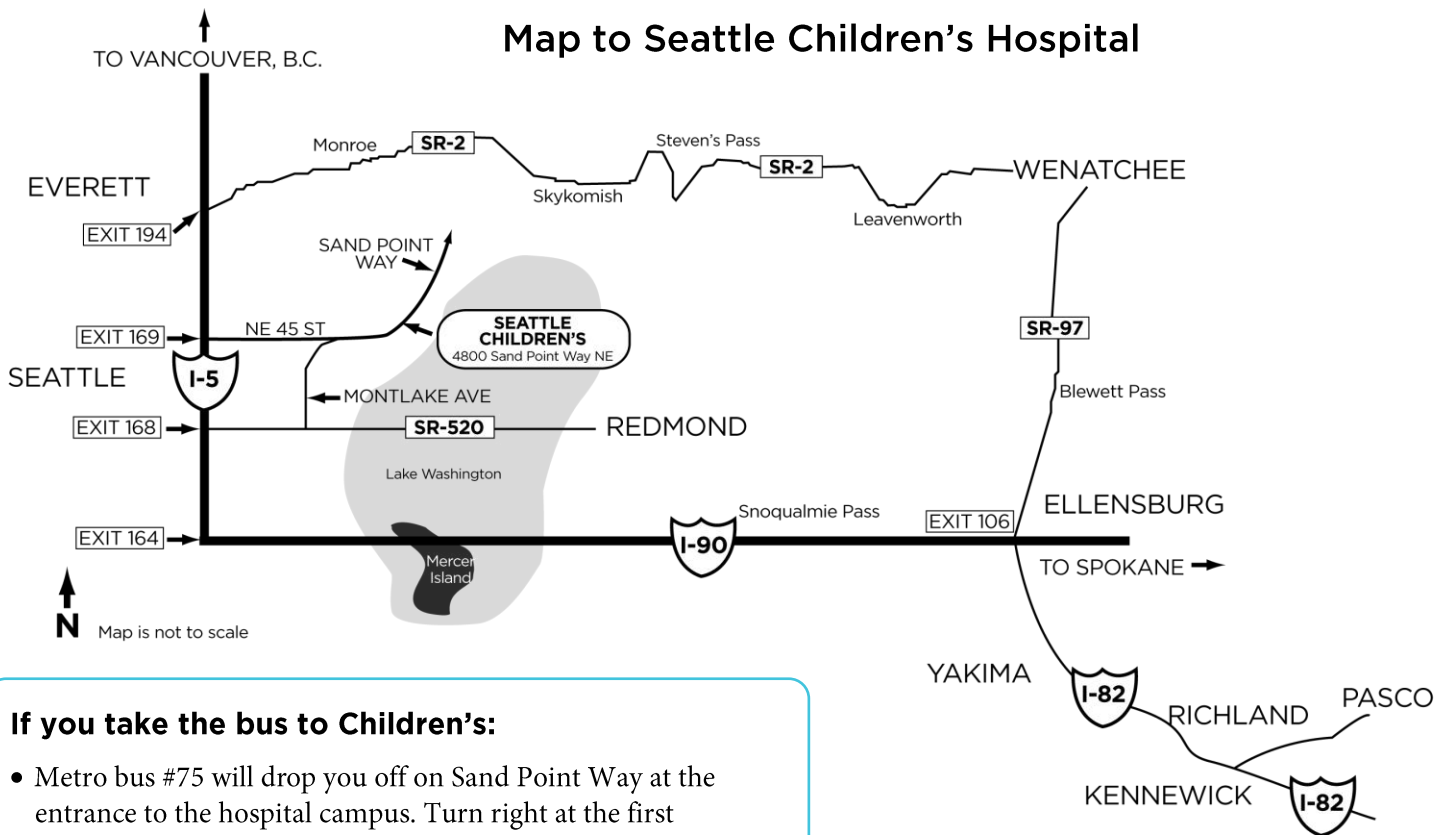
From the North: Take I-5 South to exit #169 (NE 45th Street).

Turn left (east) at the stoplight onto NE 45th Street. Go 1.5 miles, passing the University of Washington. At the bottom of the hill, turn left at the stoplight and continue on NE 45th Street. NE 45th Street will bear left, becoming Sand Point Way NE. Turn right at the stoplight onto Children's campus.

From the South: Take I-5 North to exit #169 (NE 45th Street). Stay in the right lane. Turn right at the stoplight onto NE 45th Street. Go 1.5 miles, passing the University of Washington. At the bottom of the hill, turn left at the stoplight and continue on NE 45th Street. NE 45th Street will bear left, becoming Sand Point Way NE. Turn right at the stoplight onto Children's campus.

From the Eastside: Take 520 West over the Evergreen Point Bridge. Take the Montlake exit, which will bear right (north). Continue for 1.1 miles. Bear right onto NE 45th Street, which becomes Sand Point Way NE. Turn right at the stoplight onto Children's campus. Note: There is a toll to cross the Hwy 520 bridge. You will not have to pay right away, and there are no toll booths. The owner of the vehicle will get a bill in the mail. Tolls could be up to \$5 one way, depending on the time of day. **Or:** Take I-90 and cross the Mercer Island Floating Bridge to I-5 North. Then follow "From the South" directions above.

If you take the bus to Children's:

- Metro bus #75 will drop you off on Sand Point Way at the entrance to the hospital campus. Turn right at the first driveway (Helen Lane) and use the Giraffe entrance.
- Metro bus #25 will drop you off on NE 45th Street. Follow signs to Whale parking. Walk through the garage on level 5.

Welcome to Seattle Children's

Entrance coordinators are at all public entrances to help you find your way around the hospital.

Children's offers free interpreter services for families who speak limited or no English and for the Deaf and hard of hearing. Ask an entrance coordinator for more information when you arrive.

Options for parking (all parking is free)

Whale parking: a garage at the end of the driveway, with entrances to hospital floors 4, 5 and 6. Free valet parking is offered at the Whale 6 entrance, Monday through Friday during business hours. Tall vehicles 6'10" to 8'4" should park on Whale level 6. Use Whale parking if you are going to:

- Admitting
- After Hours Clinic
- Clinics
- Radiology
- Sound Café (Cafeteria)
- Surgery Center (park and enter on level 4)
- Therapy

Giraffe parking: a garage at the beginning of the driveway. Use Giraffe parking and follow signs to Giraffe entrance if you are going to:

- Inpatient hospital rooms
- Chapel and Meditation Room

Lot 4: All families going to the Emergency Department are asked to park in Lot 4. Vehicles over 8'4" should park in Lot 4.
