## Shuttles at Seattle Children's

### Children's Guest Services Shuttle

Children's provides a free van service to and from the hospital main campus or the Bellevue Clinic and Surgery Center for patients and families traveling through Sea-Tac Airport, the Amtrak train station, ferry terminals or the Greyhound bus station in Seattle. The van is wheelchair accessible. Families can schedule pick-ups or drop-offs by calling 206-987-RIDE (7433) or e-mailing [guest.services@seattlechildrens.org](mailto:guest.services@seattlechildrens.org). Please call to reserve a ride at least one full business day in advance (call Friday for a ride on Monday).

Guest Services can also help with transportation between the hospital main campus and Bellevue Clinic and Surgery Center if needed. Call them at 206-987-9330.

### Ronald McDonald House Shuttle

Provides transportation between Children's main campus and the Ronald McDonald House. Call 206-987-2030. Please call 30 minutes before you need a ride if possible.

### Seattle Cancer Care Alliance (SCCA) Shuttle

Provides transportation between Children's main campus, Seattle Cancer Care Alliance, Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center and University of Washington Medical Center. Shuttle leaves every hour from the Whale 6 entrance. The first one is at 7:55 a.m., and the last one is at 6:55 p.m. Schedules are available at the hospital entrance desks or at [www.seattlechildrens.org/guide](http://www.seattlechildrens.org/guide).

### Other shuttles

While being treated at Children's, adults and children over 40 pounds may ride on employee shuttles to and from the University District, downtown and the hospital main campus. Seat belts must be worn.

- In the hospital, ask your child's nurse.
- From outside the hospital, call the toll-free Family Interpreting Line 1-866-583-1527. Tell the interpreter the name or extension you need.

### Medicaid transportation

Medicaid-approved families may qualify for taxi rides, bus tickets, or gas vouchers. If you are at home, call your Medicaid transportation broker 2-5 days before your visit. If you are already at Children's main campus, stop by the transportation desk on Whale 6 between 8 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

If you need transportation between Children's main campus and the Bellevue Clinic and Surgery Center, your healthcare provider can call the transportation desk at the hospital main campus to arrange a trip.

### Free air transportation
