

Directions to and from the Ronald McDonald House and Seattle Children's

The Ronald McDonald House is only a few blocks away, and getting there is easy.

Do you want to walk?

- It is a 5- to 10-minute walk.
- We suggest only walking in daylight.
- You may use a wagon to transport your child. You can find them at any hospital entrance.

Directions for walking

From Ronald McDonald House to Children's:

- From building A, B or C – Turn left on 40th Ave. N.E.
- Turn left on N.E. 50th Street.
- Make a slight right on 41st Ave. N.E.
- Walk across the street to Children's.

From Children's to Ronald McDonald House:

- At the bottom of Children's driveway – cross the street.
- Take a slight right onto 41st Ave. N.E.
- Turn left on N.E. 50th Street.
- Turn right on 40th Ave. N.E.
- Building C is at 5000 40th Ave. N.E., on your right.
- Buildings A and B are at 5130 40th Ave. N.E., on your right.

Do you need a ride?

If you and your child need a ride, the Children's Security Team can drive you. The entrance coordinators at the hospital entrances can arrange this for you, or you can call Security at 206-987-2030 (or 7-2030 from a hospital phone). You might have to wait up to 30 minutes for a ride. Also, let them know if you need a wheelchair-accessible van.



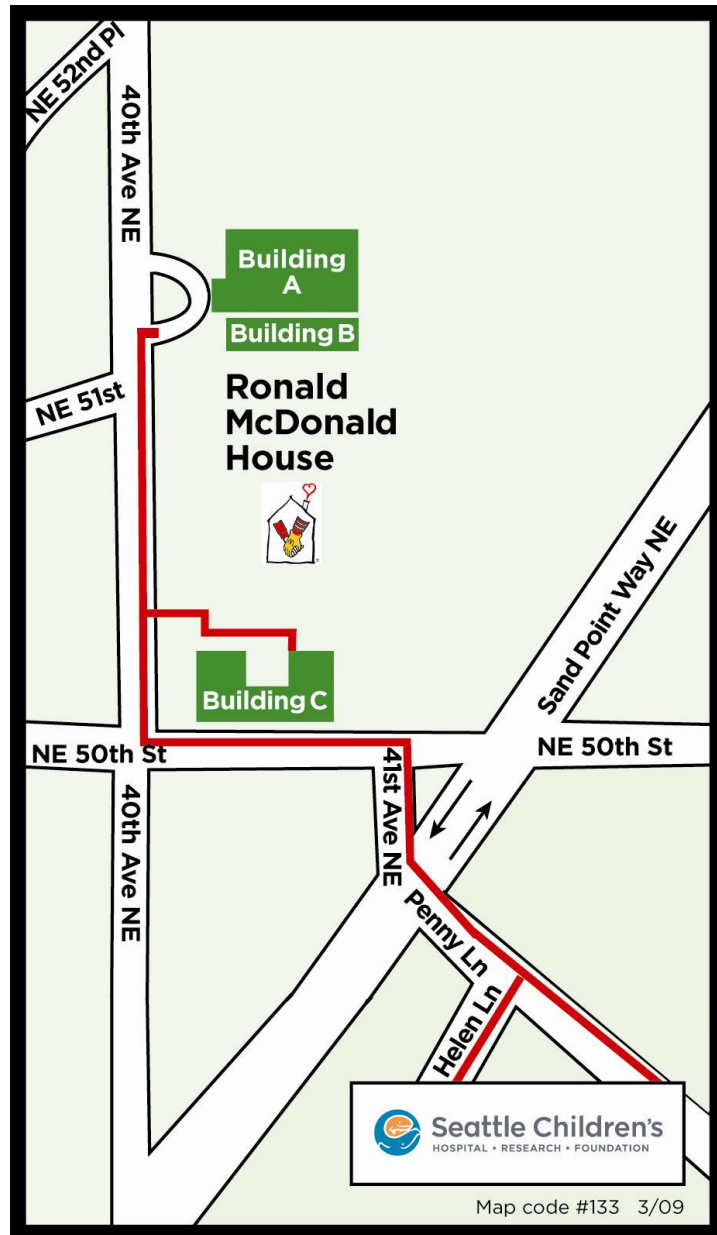
