



Diagnosis/symptom

Past cancer diagnosis at least out of cancer treatment for two years or longer

When to initiate referral:

- Has had childhood cancer and is two years or longer off therapy for their primary malignancy with no evidence of cancer no matter where they received cancer treatment

What can referring provider send?

- Previous records of cancer treatment if not treated at Children's
- Any previous data or results related to their cancer treatment or late effects

Children's workup will likely include:

- Survivors will receive comprehensive continuing care.
- Survivors will receive a comprehensive evaluation and treatment summary with recommendations for monitoring possible long-term effects.
