Letter from the Chair



Dear fellow guild members:

Congratulations on a remarkable fiscal year 2009. Amid the steepest economic downturn since the Great Depression, you raised \$10.3 million through projects, events and membership dues. These results made 2009 one of our best years, which is testimony to your passion, dedication and skill. On behalf of the board of trustees, thank you for your commitment to Seattle Children's and to the families we serve.

In the more than 10 years I've had the honor of serving the Guild Association, I've learned that the need for our support never ends. Uncompensated care reached \$96.4 million in fiscal year 2009 and is expected to exceed \$100 million in fiscal 2010. Your continued efforts are vital to ensuring that any child in our region can receive needed medical care, regardless of a family's ability to pay.

Our fiscal 2009 highlights include:

- Contributing \$10.3 million to Children's through projects, events and dues
- Raising \$1.5 million (included in the above figure) for our three-year, three-part Funding Focus, which supports the teen cancer program, cardiac innovation, and prematurity and stillbirth prevention
- Donating nearly \$10,000 and hundreds of items to "Project Teen" in support of young adult hospital patients
- Giving nearly 150,000 volunteer hours to Children's
- Welcoming 15 new guilds

As one of the top pediatric hospitals in the country, Children's is always focused on how to meet current and future demand for its services. As many of you know, the hospital has struggled for several years to have the capacity to treat all the children who needed care. Last year alone, Children's diverted nearly 80 patients to other facilities because we didn't have enough space at the Seattle hospital.

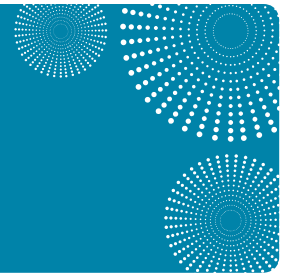

During what has been a lengthy and sometimes challenging period of planning and review, your ongoing support has been deeply appreciated. Uncompensated Care

Guild projects, events and membership dues generated \$10.3 million in fiscal year 2009. Of that amount, more than \$7.5 million went to support the hospital's uncompensated care program, the cost of which reached \$96.4 million during the fiscal year. Total guild-affiliated revenue for fiscal 2009 was more than \$16 million, a figure that includes projects, events and dues as well as individual and legacy gifts from guild members and their friends.

Our efforts took on special urgency last year as the recession increased the need for uncompensated care and threatened to restrain fundraising. The Guild Association and individual guilds responded by cutting costs, using technology more effectively and finding creative ways to increase revenue. Our combined efforts contributed significantly to the safety net of care that Seattle Children's provides for our region's children.

Funding Focus Supports Three Areas

For years, our annual Funding Focus has raised millions of dollars for needs such as facilities and research. A small portion of the money we raise for uncompensated care supports our Funding Focus. In 2009, we launched the first three-part Funding Focus, which will raise \$500,000 per year for three years for each of the following: the Adolescent and Young Adult Oncology Program; the Global Alliance to Prevent Prematurity and Stillbirth; and Seattle Children's Program in Cardiac Innovation. Each of these areas will receive \$1.5 million by the end of fiscal year 2011, when this Funding Focus concludes.

Adolescent and Young Adult Oncology Program

Research shows that if teens with cancers such as leukemia and sarcomas are treated at pediatric institutions with protocols developed specifically for them, long-term survival is 25% higher than if they are treated at adult medical institutions. Our Funding Focus will help improve facilities, expand support services, hire staff, initiate community education and advance clinical research to better serve teens and young adults with cancer.

Prematurity and Stillbirth Prevention

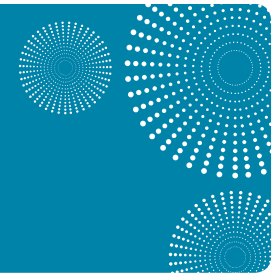
Prematurity and stillbirth are tragedies with far-reaching consequences for public health. Our Funding Focus supports the Global Alliance to Prevent Prematurity and Stillbirth (GAPPS), a collaborative initiative launched by Seattle Children's in 2007. With our support, GAPPS will develop a repository of data and specimens that will serve as a world resource in advancing medical and public health research into this crisis.

Program in Cardiac Innovation

Our Funding Focus supports the Program in Cardiac Innovation, through which Seattle Children's Heart Center will research, design, develop and test devices to improve cardiac care. Among the possibilities, the program may seek to improve mechanical pumps that assist cardiac function, or develop devices that treat congenital heart defects through cardiac catheterization, which has the benefit of being less invasive than open-heart surgery.

Friends of Costco Guild

The Friends of Costco Guild marked the 10th anniversary of the Children's Golf Classic by raising more than \$5.8 million in net revenue for uncompensated care in August 2009. The total accounted for 57% of all Guild Association project revenue raised during the fiscal year.

"I have never felt more inspired or grateful," Jan Sinegal, Friends of Costco Guild founder, said after the event. "To receive this much support in an uncertain economy is nothing short of miraculous."

Since 1999, the annual three-day Children's Golf Classic has generated more than \$40 million, making it by far the most successful fundraiser in the hospital's history.

Major sponsors gathered for a reception at Chateau Ste. Michelle Aug. 22. Jay Leno, the event's featured entertainer in 2006, returned to Safeco Field Aug. 23 to headline the anniversary celebration before 1,000 guests. Nearly 1,000 golfers played the following morning at seven area courses. Supporters gathered later that evening for an awards party at The Golf Club at Newcastle.

Symphony Guild

Guild founder and composer Mateo Messina presented the 10-movement symphony to more than 2,200 concertgoers at Benaroya Hall in Seattle Nov. 7, 2008. He was joined by Warner Bros. recording artists Easley, the Northwest Symphony Orchestra and solo electric cellist Matthew Schoening. The annual concert has made the guild a mainstay on the list of Top 25 fundraising guilds.

Hydrocephalus Research Guild

The Hydrocephalus Research Guild was formed in 2006 to support better treatments and a cure for hydrocephalus, a buildup of cerebrospinal fluid once called “water on the brain.” Every 15 minutes, someone in the country undergoes brain surgery for hydrocephalus. The guild netted \$167,000 at “Unmasking Hydrocephalus,” an event held at the Hyatt Regency Bellevue Oct. 24, 2009. The gala attracted 350 guests and featured a Venetian carnival theme and a live auction. Jan “Nino” Ramirez, PhD, director of the Center for Integrative Brain Research at Seattle Children’s Research Institute, discussed recent developments in hydrocephalus research.

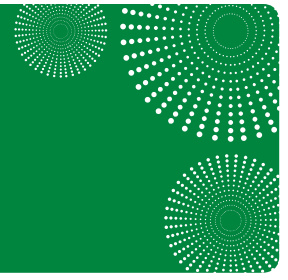

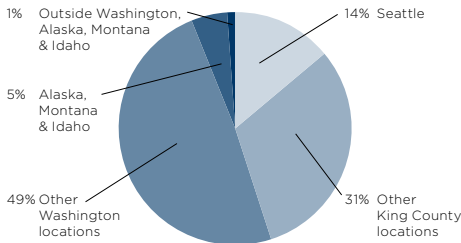

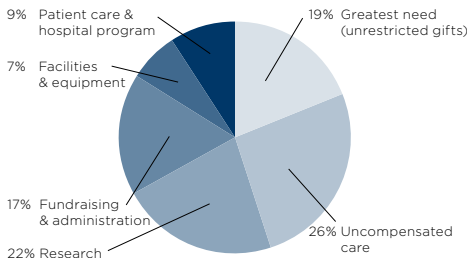

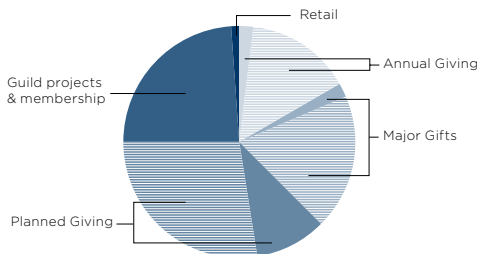
WHERE OUR INPATIENTS COME FROM
