TITLE: Removal Of IACUC Members

SUMMARY:

IACUC Committee members, including the Chairperson of the IACUC, are subject to removal for cause at the discretion of the appropriate administrative officer.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

011-1 IACUC Committee Members, including the Chairperson, are subject to removal for cause based on any of the following:

011-1.1 Fabrication, falsification, plagiarism, or other practices that seriously deviate from those that are commonly accepted within the scientific community for proposing, conducting or reporting research;

011-1.2 Any breach of confidentiality;

011-1.3 Research fraud and abuse;

011-1.4 Failure to protect the rights of animal subjects;

011-1.5 Failure to comply with attendance requirements.

011-2 Removal of a committee member shall be recommended by the Chairperson of the IACUC with approval of the Institutional Official (IO).

011-3 Removal of the IACUC Chairperson shall be recommended by the IO, with approval of the President/Chief Executive Officer (CEO).
