Individuals wearing a PFD are not allowed to go in the medium or deep areas or down 3 sides of the guarded areas. Sometimes parents are unhappy with this rule be it is necessary for a number of safety reasons. PFD's were also raffled off at two summer events - The Children's Fishing Derby in Anacortes in June and the Safe Kids Day at Clear Lake in July.
