

WHO	Should be referred to the Orthotics Clinic?	We see patients from birth through age 21 in our specialty Orthotics and Prosthetics Clinic. The most common conditions we treat are arthrogyrosis, cerebral palsy (CP), developmental dysplasia of the hip (DDH), limb deficiencies, spina bifida, positional plagiocephaly, idiopathic and neuromuscular scoliosis, clubfoot, trauma, and pectus carinatum.
WHAT	Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?	A current prescription is necessary from the referring provider. X-rays no older than 3 months old are necessary for our patients being treated for idiopathic scoliosis. If you have already done a work-up, please fax your information to 206-985-3121.
WHICH	Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?	Your child will be seen as quickly as possible with the provider on the specialty team who is the best match for managing the current problem. To meet the Orthotics and Prosthetics team CLICK HERE .
