The people who work at pools, boating programs and beaches want to help you find ways to safely enjoy the water.

If you need help paying for swimming lessons, ask about scholarships. Many pools also have special times or classes that are lower in cost. In the summer, many of the beaches with life guards offer free swim lessons. Some beaches have life guards from June to September. Check your local beach for the life guard schedule and hours.
