We are not taking referrals to Nutrition for obesity.<br/>We <i>are</i> seeing patients with binge eating disorders (wait is 3+ months), PCOs, &amp; male patients with gynecomastia.</p> | Neurology       | 0-18<br><i>Exceptions:</i><br>Progressive neurologic or neuromuscular disorder, or referrals specific to mitochondrial programs. |

| Dental               | New pts < 17 years with mild to moderate medical conditions/DD, up to 21 years if severe medical conditions, DD, craniofacial. Up to 21 years if an existing patient.  | Pain            | 0-18   |
| Dermatology          | 0-18   | Plastic Surgery | 0-21   |
| Endocrine            | 0-17 for new referrals.<br>0-18 continuing care.<br>18-21: diagnosis of delayed puberty/hypogonadism, or medical complex young adults who are being seen by other SCH specialists.   |                 |  |
| Genetics             | 0-17 for new referrals.<br>0-18 for continuing care.   | Pulmonology     | 0-21   |

| Growth/Feeding      | 9 months-4 years  |
| Hematology/Oncology | 0-21  |
| Immunology          | 0-21. Will also see adults.   |

| Nephrology          | 0-21. With active transition program for teens.<br>Hypertension: 0-18 only. |
| Neurodevelopmental  | Will see pts until their 22nd Birthday.                                     |

| Surgery                          | 0-21. Will see pts older than 21 if referred for pectus.  |
