

Adolescent Medicine: Behavioral Health

Referral Information

WHO	Should be referred to the Adolescent Medicine Clinic for Behavioral Health?	We see patients ages 12 through 20 for the following conditions: anxiety disorders including Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder, Attention Deficit Disorder, depressive disorders (non-suicidal), treatment non-adherence with chronic illness, and onset of poor school performance with no clear reason.
WHAT	Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?	No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions, although we request pertinent medical records be provided. If you have already done a work-up, please fax your information to 206-985-3121.
WHICH	Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?	Your patient will be seen as quickly as possible with the provider on the specialty team who is the best match for managing the current problem. To meet the Adolescent Medicine team CLICK HERE .
