

WHO	Should be referred to the Adolescent Medicine Clinic for eating disorders?	Our team sees patients ages 9 through 20 years of age for the following concerns: restrictive eating behaviors, bingeing or purging; weight below 85% ideal body weight, and/or absence of menses for 3 months.
WHAT	Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?	No pre-referral work-up is required. Recent clinic notes including growth grids, as well as relevant lab studies and a list of all medications should be faxed to 206-985-3121.
WHICH	Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?	Your patient will be seen as quickly as possible with the provider on the specialty team who is the best match for managing the current problem. To meet the Eating Disorders Care Team CLICK HERE .
