

<h2>WHO</h2>	<p>Should be referred to the PEARL Clinic?</p>	<p>We see patients ages 5-18 for concerns about attention, learning problems, self-regulation, and behavior issues. We offer consultation, evaluation, psychological testing (cognitive, academic), medication evaluation/management, group parent training, group therapy treatment, school advocacy, and access to research studies. <h2>WHAT</h2>	<p>Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?</p>	<p>Please assess for concerns about co-occurring conditions such as cardiac, neurological, and history of head injury. Please fax relevant medical records including prior medication trials, behavioral questionnaires (e.g. Vanderbilt), educational, and other treatment records to 206-985-3121. After submitting a referral you will receive another fax from us requesting any additional needed information as well as outlining the PCP/PEARL Clinic Collaborative Care Model. <h2>WHEN</h2>	<p>Will my patient be able to obtain an appointment?</p>	<p>Most patients will be seen within 90 days of the family calling us to be scheduled.</p>
<h2>WHICH</h2>	<p>Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?</p>	<p>Our interdisciplinary team includes clinical psychologists, licensed master's level therapists, child and adolescent psychiatrists, psychiatric nurse practitioners, and psychiatry and psychology residents and fellows.
