

WHO	Should be referred to the Autism Center?	We see patients ages 12 months to 21 years for concerns regarding Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). For those without ASD diagnoses we offer diagnostic evaluations. For those children with ASD diagnoses, we offer medication evaluation and management, short term behavioral therapies, speech and language assessment, as well as parent education and support. WHAT	Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?	No pre-referral work-up is required. If you have already done a work-up and have records related to developmental concerns, please fax those records to 206-985-3121.
WHICH	Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?	Your child will be seen as quickly as possible with the provider on the specialty team who is the best match for managing the current problem.
