

<h2>WHO</h2>	<p>Should be referred to the DSD Clinic?</p>	<p>Our multidisciplinary team provides diagnosis and long term management for patients ages 0-21 with disorders of sex development including ambiguous genitalia, micropenis or severe hypospadias with undescended testes, females with congenital adrenal hyperplasia, Turner Syndrome, Klinefelter Syndrome, primary amenorrhea, androgen insensitivity syndrome, müllerian anomalies, mosaic sex chromosome abnormalities on amniocentesis and discongruent sex chromosomes and phenotype.</p>
<h2>WHAT</h2>	<p>Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?</p>	<p>No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions. If you have already done a work-up, please fax your information to 206-985-3121.</p>
<h2>WHICH</h2>	<p>Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?</p>	<p>Patients will be seen as quickly as possible by a multidisciplinary team from Endocrinology, Genetics, Pediatric Urology, Psychiatry and Adolescent Gynecology.
