

<h2>WHO</h2>	<p>Should be referred to Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology?</p>	<p>We see patients ages birth through 20 for the following conditions: abdominal pain with possible gynecological etiology, vaginal bleeding/discharge, labial adhesions, skin conditions of the vulva, possible non-acute sexual abuse, menstrual problems, control and routine (including long acting reversible contraception), ovarian cyst or mass, vaginal mass, STD's, Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome, pelvic exams and pap smears with contraceptive management including pregnancy testing.</p>
<h2>WHAT</h2>	<p>Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?</p>	<p>No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions. If you have already done a work-up, please fax pertinent medical records, growth charts and relevant lab studies to 206-985-3121. If imaging studies have been performed, please upload to PACS or have the patient hand carry to clinic.</p>
