

<p>WHO</p>	<p>Should be referred to the Ophthalmology Clinic?</p>	<p>We see patients ages 0 to 21 for the following diagnostic procedures and conditions: abnormal pupils, albinism, amblyopia, blocked tear ducts, cataracts, colobomas, congenital malformations of eye, conjunctivitis, decreased visual acuity, dermoid cysts, electroretinograms (ERG), esotropia, exotropia, eye movement disorders, eyelid disorders, glaucoma, hemangiomas, nystagmus, optic nerve hypoplasia, optic atrophy, orbital masses, papilledema, ptosis, retinoblastoma, strabismus, styes/chalazion, tumors of eye or eyelid, uveitis/iritis, vestibular balance disorders, visual evoked potential (VEP).</p>
<p>WHAT</p>	<p>Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?</p>	<p>No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions. If your child has been seen by an eye doctor outside of Seattle Children's or you have done any other work-up, please fax your information to 206-985-3121.</p>
