

WHO	Should be referred to the Prenatal Diagnosis and Treatment Program?	We see women whose pregnancy is complicated by: abnormal prenatal screening or chromosome analysis, suspected fetal structural abnormalities, risks identified through genetic testing or genetic counseling, maternal health conditions which may affect the fetus and family history of a child with a congenital abnormality or genetic disorder.
WHAT	Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?	Please fax all clinic records from obstetric team, including primary obstetric provider, perinatologist, genetics counselor, lab results and radiology reports to 206-987-2962. Please upload imaging studies to PACS or mail a disc ahead of the clinic visit.
WHEN	Will my patient be able to obtain an appointment?	Routine, urgent and emergent appointments are available based on clinical information. Please call the Prenatal Clinic at 206-987-5629 if there are any questions.
WHICH	Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?	You will be seen as quickly as possible with the provider on the specialty team who is the best match for managing the current problem. Providers include pediatric subspecialists, and when needed, high risk obstetricians from UW. To meet the Prenatal Diagnosis and Treatment Care Team CLICK HERE .
WHERE	Will my patient be seen?	Most prenatal clinics are held in Seattle at the Springbrook Professional Center. Certain appointments are scheduled at the hospital and in some of our regional sites. For maps and directions CLICK HERE .
