

<h2>WHO</h2>	<p>Should be referred to the Pulmonary and Sleep Medicine Clinic?</p>	<p>We see patients ages 0-21 for the following conditions: asthma, recurrent cough or wheeze, bronchopulmonary dysplasia, chronic lung disease, cystic fibrosis, spine and chest wall disorders and sleep disorders.</p>
<h2>WHAT</h2>	<p>Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?</p>	<p>No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions. If imaging studies have already been done, please upload to PACS. Images that cannot be sent electronically should be put on a CD that is DICOM format compatible and mailed to the pulmonary clinic or hand carried by the parent to the appointment. Please fax clinic notes that are relevant to the referral, including growth charts, to 206-985-3121.</p>
