

<b>WHO</b>	Should be referred to the Rehabilitation Medicine Clinic at Seattle Children's?	We see patients all ages for the following conditions: traumatic brain injury, acquired brain injury, spinal cord injury, Guillian-Barre syndrome, muscular dystrophy, function problems related to cancer, stroke, neuromuscular diseases, brachial plexus injuries, gait abnormalities, cerebral palsy and arthrognosis.
<b>WHAT</b>	Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?	No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions. Outside therapy records are helpful to have prior to the visit, as well as genetic testing results and muscle biopsy results if they have been done. If you have these records or if you have already done a work-up, please fax your information to 206-985-3121.
