

<p>WHO</p>	<p>Should be referred to the Rheumatology Clinic?</p>	<p>We see patients ages 0 to 17 for the following conditions: possible arthritis, swollen or painful joint(s), dermatomyositis, muscle weakness, fever of unknown origin, possible SLE, raynaud's, scleroderma syndromes, and vasculitis.</p>
<p>WHAT</p>	<p>Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?</p>	<p>No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions. If you have already done a work-up, please fax your information to 206-985-3121.</p>
