

WHO	Should be referred to the Transplant Center?	Seattle Children's Transplant Center offers comprehensive evaluation and care to children from birth to 21 years of age with end-stage diseases of the heart, liver, kidneys and intestine. Your child's care will be coordinated by an organ transplant specialist dedicated to providing care, information and support along the way.
WHAT	Work-up is needed prior to the first appointment?	No pre-referral work-up is required for most conditions. If you have already done a work-up, please fax your information to 206-987-3955 or email to pediatric.transplant@seattlechildrens.org .
WHEN	Will my patient be able to obtain an appointment?	Clinic appointments are scheduled based on clinical urgency. Please call for appointment information.
WHICH	Provider will my patient see at the first appointment?	Your child will be seen as quickly as possible with the provider on the specialty team who is the best match for managing the current problem. To meet the Transplant Center Team CLICK HERE .
