Assessment & Plan: Consults: Orthopedics arrived at 2130, examined patient, and recommend a spica cast for the fractured femur. They will admit to their service for spica teaching. The spica will be placed in the operating room tomorrow, and Ortho will splint in the emergency department tonight. Scan Dr.: Discussed case by phone at 2150. Scan Dr. recommends admission to hospital, as well as skeletal survey. They also recommend checking coagulation studies for blood work.

Summary of ED Visit to PCP:

Patient came to the ED complaining of a swollen right thigh. Called Orthopedics for a consult and they recommended a spica cast for the fractured femur.

Patient will be admitted to the orthopedic service. Follow up with the fractured femur and see if the bone is healing.
