

## **Celine A. Saulnier, PhD**

Celine Saulnier, Ph.D., is the Director of Research Operations at the Marcus Autism Center and Associate Professor in the Division of Autism and Related Disorders, Department of Pediatrics at Emory University School of Medicine. She obtained her doctorate in Clinical Psychology from the University of Connecticut, after which she completed a postdoctoral fellowship at the Yale Child Study Center before joining their faculty.

At Yale, Dr. Saulnier was both the Clinical Director and the Training Director for the Yale Autism Program, conducting and overseeing diagnostic evaluations on children with autism and related disorders. At Marcus, one of the nation's largest centers for the clinical care of autism, Dr. Saulnier directs a large-scale diagnostic assessment core for individuals participating in research. She specializes in the early detection of autism symptoms in the first two years of life.
