Dr. Orlich is the Director of Community Outreach at Seattle Children's Autism Center and a Clinical Associate Professor at the University of Washington. Felice received her PHD in psychology from UC - San Diego School of Medicine. She completed a fellowship in child Psychiatry at Stanford University School of Medicine.
