

## **Dalia M. Feltman, MD, MA**

Dalia M. Feltman has practiced neonatology at NorthShore University HealthSystem's Evanston Hospital in Evanston, IL since 2008. She is a Senior Clinician Educator at the University of Chicago's Pritzker School of Medicine. Dr. Feltman received her BS from Marquette University after majoring in biology and theology, and her MD from Loyola University of Chicago's Stritch School of Medicine, where she later completed her pediatric residency and neonatal-perinatal medicine fellowship. This spring, Dr. Feltman received her MA in Bioethics and Health Policy at Loyola University's Neiswanger Institute for Bioethics and Health Policy.

Dr. Feltman is a member of the AAP's Sections on Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine, Bioethics, and Hospice and Palliative Medicine. She is a Neonatal Resuscitation Program Hospital-Based Instructor. She serves on her neonatal unit's Committee on Palliative Care and will serve on the healthcare system's Institutional Review Board this fall. She has reviewed ethics-focused manuscripts for the *American Journal of Bioethics* and MIT Press.

Dr. Feltman's academic interests include research ethics and decision-making for critically ill newborns. She has co-authored Ethics Rounds cases on these topics in *Pediatrics* and published an empiric study of neonatologists' views on limiting life-sustaining treatments in the *Journal of Perinatology*.
