

## **Kellie Lang, JD, RN**

Kellie Lang, JD, RN is Assistant Professor of Bioethics & Medical Humanities and Pediatrics in the Center for Bioethics & Medical Humanities at the Medical College of Wisconsin (MCW.) Kellie is a team leader for clinical ethics consultation and is chair of the education subcommittee for the Ethics Advisory Committee at Children's Hospital of Wisconsin where she also serves as a nursing ethics consultant and provides staff education. She teaches in the graduate and residency programs at MCW and serves on a community hospital's ethics committee.

Kellie's research interests include the role of law in pediatric health policy; the impact of ethics education on moral distress of care providers; and the effect of, and strategies to address, implicit bias and racism in pediatric health care. She is a director-at-large for the American Society of Bioethics & Humanities and co-editor of the Legal Notes section of the Pediatric Ethics Consortium. Kellie is author of a law review article, "Gavels in the Nursery," in the Annals of Health Law.
