

## **Ryan M. Antiel, MD, MSME**

Dr. Antiel is currently a resident in the Department of General Surgery at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, where he also has an appointment as Assistant Professor of Biomedical Ethics. His clinical interest is in pediatric surgery. Dr. Antiel was a Fellow of Advanced Biomedical Ethics in the Department of Medical Ethics & Health Policy at the University of Pennsylvania from 2014-2016. After completing pre-medical studies at the Johns Hopkins University, Dr. Antiel earned his medical degree from Mayo Medical School. He was previously an Edmund Pellegrino fellow at Georgetown University's Center for Clinical Bioethics. His scholarship explores how philosophical, religious and political concepts form the moral life generally and medical decision-making and health policy specifically. His recent interests have focused on treatment recommendations and decision-making in seriously ill fetuses and neonates. His work has appeared in leading journals including the New England Journal of Medicine, JAMA Surgery, and Pediatrics.
